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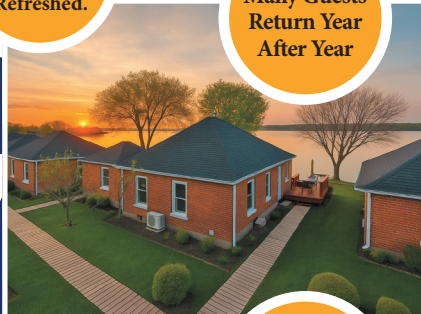
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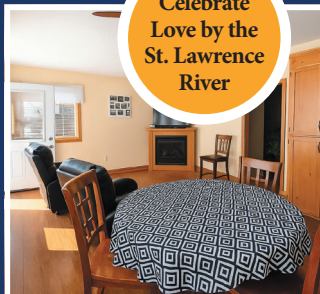

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APPALACHIAN ROAD SHOW

Appalachian Region U.S.A. 

Formed in 2018, Appalachian Road Show has quickly become one of modern bluegrass and Americana music's most engaging and authentic voices. Built on a shared love for preserving the culture, stories, and spirit of Appalachia, the band blends outstanding musicianship, heartfelt songwriting, rich harmonies, and deeply rooted storytelling into a live experience that truly connects with audiences.

The Appalachian Road Show takes listeners on a journey across the landscapes of Appalachia — from coalfields and churches to rail lines and front porches. Their songs explore themes of faith, hardship, family, work, love, loss, resilience and heritage, painting a picture that is both timeless and deeply human. More than just a concert, their performances feel like a shared cultural experience.

The core of the band includes Barry Abernathy on banjo, Jim VanCleve on fiddle, Darrell Webb on mandolin, and Zeb Snyder on guitar. Abernathy, VanCleve and Webb were all born and raised in Appalachia. Abernathy grew up near the head of the Appalachian Trail in northern Georgia and began singing in church at just 10 years old. His grandmother owned a banjo and despite being born with only one finger on his picking hand, he was determined from an early age to learn the instrument and the music of his heritage.

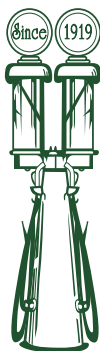

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EDGAR LOUDERMILK BAND

Georgia, U.S.A. 

Surrounded by music at an early age, Loudermilk was only nine when he began playing bass in his family's band, and continued to play in the band until he was 20 years old. Afterwards, he decided to join a band named Carolina Crossfire, which had quite a following in the Georgia area. It wasn't long before Loudermilk decided to expand his options and try his hand at playing professionally, a decision that has made him a staple for elite artists in bluegrass music. This Georgia-based band is led by Edgar Loudermilk, a two-time, back to back winner of SPBGMA's "Bass Fiddle Performer of the Year" and also a Josie Music Awards 2024 Bass Player of the Year. Edgar Loudermilk's signature voice, award-winning bass skills, and songwriting have become his trademark. Edgar and the band, individually and collectively, have garnered over 50 industry awards and nominations. The music styling of the Edgar Loudermilk Band encompasses bluegrass, gospel, country and Americana genres. The band tours coast-to-coast and throughout Canada.

In addition to touring and performing, Edgar Loudermilk has had great success as a songwriter, with numerous self-penned songs, many of which have been recorded by others.

DAVID TINKOFF MIKE O'REILLY AWARD

Each year at the South Grenville Bluegrass Festival, The Ottawa Valley Bluegrass Music Association presents the **David Tinkoff Award** and the **Mike O'Reilly Award**. This is given to a person or persons who has/have made a significant contribution to the Ottawa Valley Bluegrass community over a long period of time as a musician and an organizer or promoter. The awards are given in memory of David Tinkoff, a long-time Association member and musician. The donation of whose mandolin after his untimely death, initially financed the awards and Mike O'Reilly, perhaps the most accomplished Bluegrass musician and songwriter to ever come out of the Ottawa Valley. The winners are selected by the Association's Awards Committee chaired by Lynn Thom, Vice President and including two permanent members David Porter and Pat Moore, Board members Donald Tarte and Bill Henry and the previous year's winners.

Nominations may be put forward by any Bluegrass fan to any committee member at any time. A list of nominees is maintained by the committee and updated annually for review and selection at the decision meeting each spring. Winners do not have to be Association members and may be deceased.

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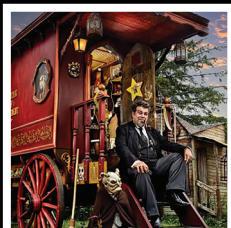
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THIRD HARMONY

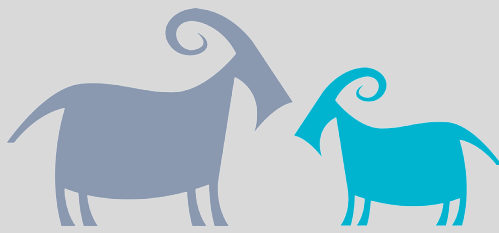
New Brunswick, CA



Third Harmony is a band from New Brunswick that was founded in 2015. Since then, they have been perfecting their craft, from the chilling harmonies to the precise musicianship. These musicians are no strangers to the bluegrass circuit; Gerry Richard on guitar and vocals, daughter Natasha Richard on fiddle and vocals, Dan Maillet on banjo and vocals and Ron Savoie on mandolin and vocals. This group would not be complete without the impressive talents of Marcel Duplesis on bass. These guys bring a mix of old traditional and contemporary bluegrass music, along with some high energy toe tapping fiddle tunes. A few years ago, Third Harmony released their first album titled “Stepping Up”. In 2019, they won “Recording of the year”, “Vocal group of the year” and “Female vocalist of the year (Natasha)” at the Eastern Canada Bluegrass Music Awards.

The group performs actively across the bluegrass circuit, including notable appearances at the Nova Scotia Bluegrass & Oldtime Music Festival, the Downeast Bluegrass Festival and even showcase performances at Dollywood.
